



Referrer information sheet

Who's eligible?

- · Aged 18 years and over
- HbA1c between 42-47 mmol/mol (6.0-6.4%) or Fasting Plasma Glucose between 5.5-6.9 mmol/I within the last 24 months
- If patient has a history of Gestational Diabetes (GDM) then patient is eligible with HbA1c < 42 mmol/mol or FPG < 5.5mmol/l.
- Not pregnant
- Able to take part in light/moderate physical activity

What are the stages of the Healthier You: NHS Diabetes Prevention Programme?

- Programme overview, including understanding individual needs and motivations
- Assess lifestyle scores
- Signposting onto other services

End of programme one-to-one review:

- Reassess lifestyle scores
- Evaluation of progress
- Evaluation of service
- Signposting onto other services
- Goal setting and review
