

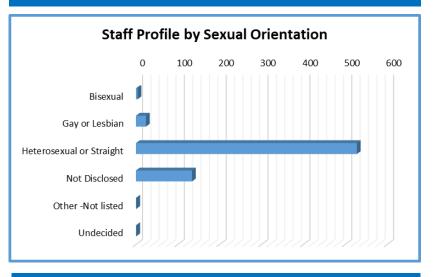

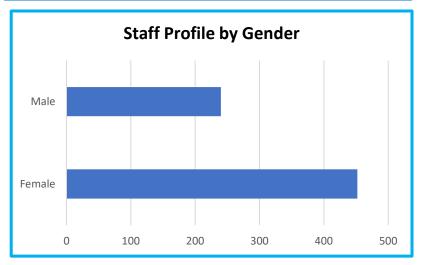

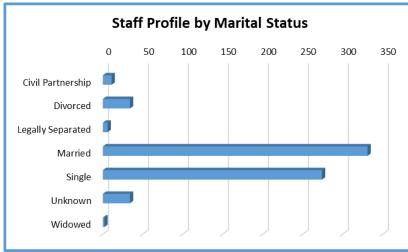
Staff Profile by Sexual Orientation



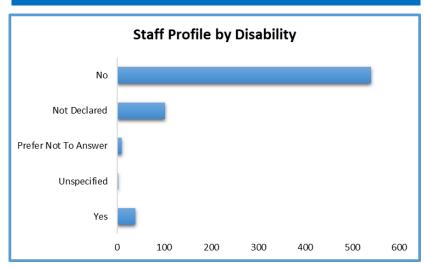
Staff Profile by Gender



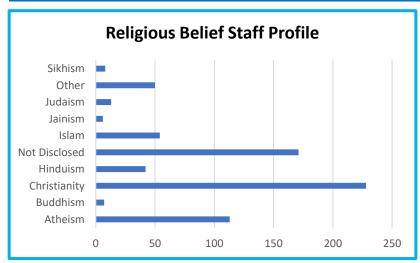
Staff Profile by Marital Status



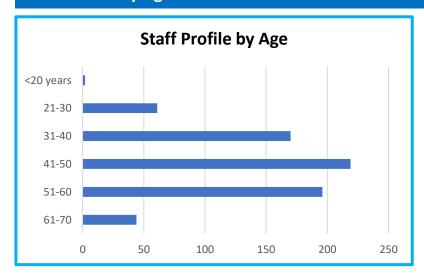
Staff Profile by Disability



Staff Profile by Religious Belief

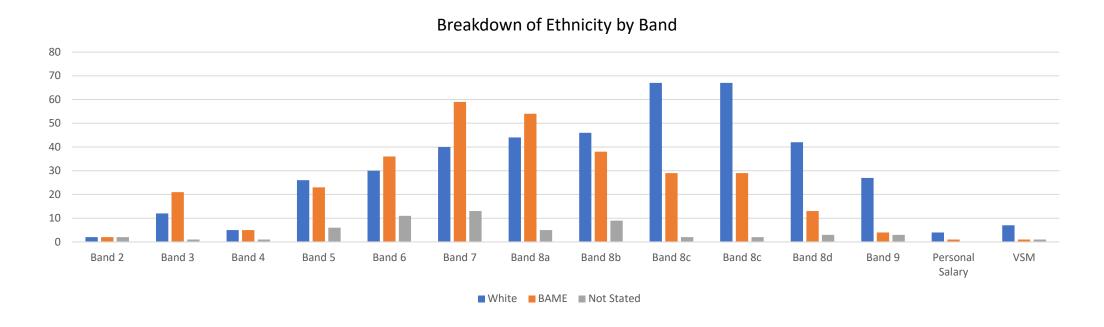

Commentary

- ☐ Whilst the majority of staff within the ICB do not have a disability, approximately 13.5% of staff have chosen not to declare a disability.
- ☐ The majority of staff are within the age 41-50 age bracket, followed closely by 51-60 and the 31-40 age bracket.
- ☐ The majority of the ICB workforce are female (65%)
- A higher proportion of ICB staff in roles that are band 3, 6, 7 and 8A are from a BAME background than a white background. In contrast, this is reversed for roles 8B to VSM, in which there are a significantly higher proportion of staff that are from a white background than a BAME background.
