




Adult vaccinations and when to have them





Flu vaccine – given every year from September to March



Shingles vaccine (two doses given between 8 weeks to 6 months apart)



Shingles vaccine (those turning 65 from the 1st September will be eligible for Shingles, two dosesgiven between 6 to 12 months apart)



- Pneumococcal vaccine (One dose required)
- Flu vaccine given every year from September to March
